## **Briarwood Boating Rules**

- 1. All vessels are required to operate at a no wake speed. PWC, tubbing or water skiing are prohibited.
- 2. Kayaks, canoes and paddle boats are for daily use only and may not be moored overnight or left unattended. Items left unattended will be removed at the discretion of BAA.
- 3. Boats and trailers using Briarwood waters and parking lots must have a valid Briarwood sticker affixed.
- Seasonal boat mooring is allowed through an annual lottery.

- 5. All vessels operating on waters owned by Briarwood Estates need to be registered and titled by the state of MO with the exception of: non-motorized vessels, sailboats 12' or less and vessels registered in other states using MO waters for 60 consecutive days or less. The state registration number and validation decal must be displayed per state regulations.
- 6. All motorboat operators and vessels are required to follow MO boating laws and responsibilities as stated in the handbook of MO boating laws and responsibilities. - 7. Legal age to operate a motorboat in MO/Briarwood is 14yrs. of age, unless under the direct, on board supervision of a parent, guardian or other person 16yrs. of age or older. Parents and guardians are legally responsible for the underage operator and there actions.
